NOTES:

Both Cathleen Rogers (the Democratic Elections Commissioner in Hamilton County) and a spokesman for Dominion (the voting machine vendor) confirmed that the source codes for machines in Hamilton County were "reprogrammed" in the days prior to the election.

There is a discrepancy in the vote count for Scozzafava. As the numbers in Scozzafava's column add up, it is most likely an error in the newspaper.

The most anomalous precincts were Lake Pleasant, where Owens got only 23% of the vote, and Indian Lake's 1st and 2nd districts, where Hoffman got only 38% and 25% of the vote. These numbers are so far out of line as to arouse suspicion.
