The countywide totals in this spreadsheet match those in the Watertown Daily Times. As all of Lewis County is included in the 23<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District, these numbers have to be incomplete, with only 19 of 31 precincts (election districts) reporting.

The most anomalous precincts are Diana's  $2^{nd}$  district, where Hoffman got only 32% of the vote, and Lewis, where Owens got only 16% of the vote. These numbers almost have to be wrong.
